

THIS DEED OF CORRECTION is made and entered into this 7th day of July, 2004, and effective as of January 29, 2004, by and between PYXIS RESOURCES COMPANY, a Virginia corporation, CLINCHFIELD COAL COMPANY, a Virginia corporation, PARAMONT COAL CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation, hereinafter collectively referred to as Grantors, and HEARTWOOD FORESTLAND FUND IV, L.P., a North Carolina limited partnership, whose address is c/o The Forestland Group, LLC, 1512 East Franklin Street, Suite 104, Chapel Hill, NC 27514, hereinafter referred to as Grantee.

WHEREAS, by deed dated January 29, 2004, of record in the Circuit Court Clerk's Office of Russell County, Virginia, in Deed Book 601, Page 920 (the "Deed"), the Grantors conveyed to Grantee certain tracts of surface, timber, gravel and building stone located in Russell County, Virginia.

WHEREAS, the Grantee in the Deed was incorrectly identified as "Heartland Forestland Fund IV, L.P.," and the correct name of the Grantee is "Heartwood Forestland Fund IV, L.P."

WHEREAS, specific property descriptions for additional tracts which were conveyed by Grantor to Grantee are now known, and the parties wish to include said descriptions in the Deed.

WHEREAS, the Grantors and Grantee desire to correct the name of the Grantee by entering into this deed of correction and to include more specific property descriptions for additional tracts conveyed by Grantor to Grantee.

WITNESSETH:

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the recitals sets forth above and other valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties do hereby:

I. Delete the first paragraph of the Deed and insert the following paragraph in its place to correct the identity of the Grantee in the Deed:

THIS DEED is made and entered into this 29<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2004, by and between PYXIS RESOURCES COMPANY, a Virginia corporation, CLINCHFIELD COAL COMPANY, a Virginia corporation, and PARAMONT COAL CORPORATION, a

Delaware corporation, hereinafter collectively referred to as Grantors, and HEARTWOOD

FORESTLAND FUND IV, L.P., a North Carolina limited partnership, whose address is c/o The Forestland Group, LLC, 1512 East Franklin Street, Suite 104, Chapel Hill, NC 27514, hereinafter referred to as Grantee.

II. Include the following specific property descriptions in the Deed:

Tract 60 (Duty SW, M. P. Artrip 0.13 acre)

All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the County of Russell, State of Virginia, on waters of Laurel Branch of Dumps Creek, adjoining the lands of Maggie Gilliam and husband, J. W. Holbrook et al, and Alvin Rasnick et al, and bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on a hillside with locust witness on a line of lot of J. W. Holbrook et al, and a corner to Wallace and Maggie Gilliam's land and running with Gilliam's lines, N 31 54 E 64.84 feet to a stake on a hillside, S 56 46 E 97.55 feet to a stake near a rock pile on a line of lot of Alvin Rasnick et al and running with said lot, S 58 56 W. 67.78 feet to a stake on a line of lot of J. W. Holbrook et al and running with the same N 45 22 W 66.44 feet to the BEGINNING. Containing thirteen one-hundredths of an acre by planimeter calculation.

P. Kiser 266 acre tract; thence leaving the lines of the W. W. Laforce 482 acre tract and with the lines of the J. P. Kiser 266 acre tract and still continuing with lines of the J. M. Kiser 1488 acre tract, and the branch, North fifty-three degrees sixteen minutes West (N 53° 16' W) five hundred twenty-four and twenty-six hundredths (524.26) feet to a stake North forty-nine degrees nine minutes West (N 49° 09' W) two hundred eighty-four and eighty-seven hundredths (284.87) feet to a stake, North fifty-six degrees twenty-nine minutes West (N 56° 29' W) six hundred fifteen and nineteen hundredths (615.19) feet to a stake, North seventy degrees twenty-three minutes West (N 70° 23' W) five hundred four and thirty-seven hundredths (504.37) feet to a stake, North twenty-five degrees five minutes West (N 25° 05' W) one hundred eighty-four and eighty seven hundredths (184.87) feet to a stake, North sixty degrees forty two minutes West (N 60° 42' W) two hundred thirty-one and fifty three hundredths (231.53) feet to a stake, North twenty-nine degrees thirty-four minutes West (N 29° 34' W) one hundred sixteen and eleven hundredths (116.11) feet to a stake, North seventy-eight degrees eleven minutes West (N 78° 11' W) ninety-three and thirty hundredths (93.30) feet to a stake, North forty-five degrees thirty minutes West (N 45° 30' W) one hundred seventy-one and twenty eight hundredths (171.28) feet to a stake, North sixty-six degrees thirty-eight minutes West (N 66° 38' W) one hundred forty-six and fifty two hundredths (146.52) feet to a stake, North fifty-one degrees forty-three minutes West (N 51° 43' W) one hundred forty-four and fifty-two hundredths (144.52) feet to a stake, North eighty-three degrees fifty-seven minutes West (N 83° 57' W) one hundred sixty-one and ninety-seven hundredths (161.97) feet to a stake, North sixty-seven degrees twenty-five minutes West (N 67° 25' W) two hundred ten and fifty-four hundredths (210.54) feet to the Beginning, Containing by planimeter calculation two hundred fifty-one and twenty one hundredths (251.21) acres, more or less.

The Grantors also expressly reserve and except from the foregoing conveyance the following tract or parcel of surface land lying on Sandy Ridge on the northeast side of Va. Rte. 657 at approximately 1.4 mile south of its intersection with Va. Rte. 699, and being located in the Ervinton Magisterial District of Dickenson County, Virginia, and being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

F. and Marshall Kiser acre tract being divided hereby, and lands now or formerly owned by Arthur L. 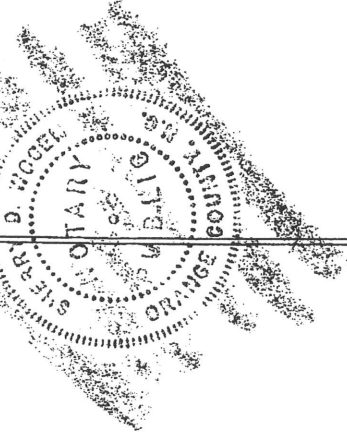
