

Background for Offset Verification Statement

Section 95977.1(b)(3)(R) of the Cap-and-Trade Regulation requires an offset verification body to issue an Offset Verification Statement for any Offset Project Data Report for which it has provided offset verification services. The offset verification body must provide the Offset Verification Statement to both the Offset Project Registry and the Offset Project Operator or Authorized Project Designee contracting the offset verification services. This form is designed to help offset verification bodies fulfill the requirements of Section 95977.1(b)(3)(R).

Where to Submit Information Contained in This Form

Please complete the information on the form using your computer. Then either add an electronic signature to the form or print, sign, and scan the form. The completed and signed information and all supporting documentation should be submitted to the appropriate Offset Project Registry.

A copy of the Offset Verification Statement must be provided also to the Offset Project Operator or Authorized Project Designee.

Detailed Instructions for Offset Verification Statement

The information should be submitted by the lead verifier of the offset verification team providing offset verification services. This form is protected with restricted editing to facilitate completing the form. If the applicant wishes to unprotect the form, the password is "form".

Part I. Offset Project Information:

- Enter the name of the offset project for which offset verification services were performed.
- Provide the offset project's identification number as issued by the Offset Project Registry with which the offset project is listed. If you know the ARB project ID number, please also provide it.
- Enter the names of the Offset Project Operator (OPO) and, if applicable, the Authorized Project Designee (APD) for the offset project.
- Indicate the start and end dates of the Reporting Period for the Offset Project Data Report being verified.
- Provide the total number of GHG reductions and/or removal enhancements reported in the *final* Offset Project Data Report (OPDR) being verified. For an OPDR with multiple versions, this assists OPR and ARB staff with matching the OVS to the corresponding final OPDR.

Part II. Verification Information:

- Enter the name of the offset verification body providing offset verification services.
- Also provide the verification body's identification number assigned by ARB. That is the number of the Executive Order issued by ARB's Executive Officer accrediting the offset verification body.
- Check the appropriate box indicating whether the Offset Project Data Report is reasonably assured of being free of offset material misstatement.
- Check the appropriate box indicating whether the Offset Project Data Report is reasonably assured of being in conformance with quantification, monitoring, and metering requirements of the Cap-and-Trade Regulation and the applicable Compliance Offset Protocol.
- Check the appropriate box indicating (1) whether the offset project is in conformance with all other provisions of the Cap-and-Trade Regulation and applicable Compliance Offset Protocol, excluding quantification, monitoring, and metering requirements and (2) whether the offset project is in compliance with all local, regional, and national requirements related to the operation of the offset project as specified in Section 3, Eligibility Rules, of the applicable Compliance Offset Protocol. If the project is not in compliance with all local, regional, and national requirements but has excluded a period of time in its Offset Project Data Report, pursuant to section 95973(b)(1), such that the project is in compliance the remainder of the reporting period, then the verification body may indicate the project is in compliance with the local, regional, and national requirements.
- Check the appropriate box indicating whether the Offset Verification Statement is Positive, Qualified Positive, or Adverse. A Qualified Positive Offset Verification Statement may not be issued to an offset project using the Compliance Offset Protocol U.S. Forest Projects. The charts below illustrate the appropriate outcome of the Offset Verification Statement based on project type and Part IV checkboxes selected.

Part III. Attestations and Signatures:

- Both the lead verifier of the offset verification team and the independent reviewer of the team must provide the required attestations in Part III.A and Part III.B to complete the Offset Verification Statement.
- An officer with the authority to represent and legally bind the Offset Verification should sign the statement in Part III.C. This officer may be, but does not have to be, either the lead verifier or the independent reviewer.
- The lead verifier, independent reviewer, and verification body officer should provide their signature, printed name, organization title, and date signed.
